placement. All students, including
returning ones, will need to complete
additional enrollment documents

THANK YOU to those parents who have kept their child home when they weren't feeling well. Your assistance goes a long way toward keeping HOPE a healthy place for children.

All families should notify the HOPE office of ALL student absences by calling 703-729-4673. If a child has been diagnosed by a physician with a contagious illness, we will send a confidential email to all affected families.

Keep your child home with the following symptoms:

- Fever in the past 24 hours
- Vomit in the past 24 hours
- Diarrhea in the past 24 hours
- Positive Covid, Flu, Strep, or RSV
- Excessive coughing or sneezing
- Crusty nose or mucus
- Pink eye/oozing eye
- Unusual spots or rash on skin
- Head Lice



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# Registration for School Year 2025-2026

Class placement will begin for our currently enrolled students, their siblings, and alumni students on Monday, February 3rd. The link for the Registration Application form was emailed to all of our enrolled students. If you are planning to enroll a child for next year, please be sure to complete the application on our website and drop off the \$175 non-refundable registration fee.

Evelyn and Lesly will process the forms in the order in which they are received. They will then contact families the results during the week of February 3rd. If you do not receive your desired placement or you wish to change your placement, please contact the preschool office at 703-729-4673.

Once this initial group has been processed, Evelyn and Lesly will begin to make verbal offers to the families who have had no prior affiliation with HOPE. Registration will then be ongoing throughout the summer until all preschool spots have been filled.





## Remember...

HOPE students must have an updated physical form on file by August 1st, 2025 to be enrolled at HOPE Preschool. The physical must have been performed no more than 12 months prior to the first day of the school year, September 2, 2025.

\*Forms may be downloaded from our website beginning in May.

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Your tuition account must be current in order for you to secure a registration placement!

# Parent/Teacher Conferences

Throughout the month of February, teachers will be connecting with families to discuss each child's progress. These conferences are always so helpful and enlightening. # Kindergarten Registration Information



Loudoun County Public School's online kindergarten pre-registration portal is open for the 2025-2026 school year on. Please check lcps.org for the link. A Parent Registration Checklist along with all required registration paperwork is also available at lcps.org. (The checklist is also shown on the last page of this newsletter.)

Virginia law requires that your child be 5 years old by September 30, 2025 to register and attend public kindergarten...no exceptions. If you choose to wait one more year before enrolling, contact your child's elementary school.
