Keep up the reading and introduce them to letters and words via "environmental print"-road signs, food labels, store names, etc. Kids who become adult readers often have special and warm memories of reading with their parents.

Speaking of reading, we are very excited about an upcoming event! Each year, HOPE Preschool participates in an event called Week of the Young Child, which is an annual celebration sponsored by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC). The purpose of the Week of the Young Child™ is to focus public attention on the needs of young children and their families and to recognize the early childhood programs and services that meet those needs. This is a weeklong event. And each day

of the week will include a theme. One way that HOPE participates is to create a school-wide display of child-generated projects, all centering on a central theme. Our theme this year is "Children's Literature". The hallways will be filled with creative and interesting displays that you won't want to miss! Be sure to come inside at some point during the week of March 24-28 to see the display, and be sure to visit our Scholastic Book Fair during that same week. Your teachers will share additional details at a later date.

Virginia law requires that your child be 5 years old by September 30, 2025 to register for and attend public kindergarten...no exceptions.






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Scholastic Book Fair

Looking Ahead to next year...

Each enrolled child must have a School Health Form on file by August 1, 2025. This is a requirement by the Virginia Department of Social Services. Your child's physical exam must have been performed no more than 12 months prior to the first day of school, September 8, 2025. School Health Forms are available at your pediatrician's office, as well as in the HOPE Office. Starting in May, all enrollment forms, including the health form, will be available on our website.

Honey's Irish Soda Bread

4 cups all purpose flour 4 1/2 tsp. baking powder 1 TB. baking soda 1 1/2 tsp. salt 1/2 cup sugar 1 TB. caraway seeds 1 cup raisins 2 cups buttermilk In large bowl, mix flour, baking powder, baking soda, salt, sugar, caraway seeds and raisins.

Add buttermilk and toss with a fork until dry ingredients are evenly moistened. Knead dough 3 or 4 times and shape into a round loaf. Place into a lightly greased pan. Cut a cross into the loaf and bake in a 375 degree oven for 45-50 minutes or until golden brown and crusty.

Cool bread on a wire rack. Store tightly wrapped at room temperature.
