Notes from the Office

Happy Fall!

The cooler air and changing leaves are so refreshing! Autumn is such a fun time of year, full of exciting moments. At HOPE, it feels like we've settled into a wonderful rhythm. The first few weeks of preschool have been all about building friendships, practicing social skills, and learning how to navigate being part of a group. The kids are doing a fantastic job, not just with academic tasks but also learning how to walk in line, listen to their teachers, share and take turns, walk down the hall holding hands with you, and slowly gaining confidence in bigger tasks.

At home, you can support their growing independence in simple, age-appropriate ways. This could mean letting them put away their backpack and jacket, help set the dinner table, feed the family pet, or pick out their shirt for school (from a couple of options). Involving them in daily routines like helping choose groceries (with guidance) or practicing buckling their car seat are great ways to encourage selfconfidence and responsibility. If your child speaks more than one language, you can also support our teachers by teaching them some helpful English phrases to express their needs at school.

We understand that electronics are a part of everyday life, and they can have their place. But balancing screen time with opportunities for creative play can open up a world of exploration and problem-solving. Puzzles, building toys, supplies, dolls, cars, and other hands-on activities give kids the chance to use their imagination, strengthen fine motor skills, and discover new interests. It's a great way for children to explore beyond their favorite TV or movie characters and engage their senses. We, as adults, are often connected to our devices too, so choosing to put them aside and spend quality time together can make a big difference in these special years.

All of these small moments of practice build upon each other, helping your child grow in confidence and setting them up for a successful school year! This month, we're excited about our upcoming school field trip to Pumpkin Village in Leesburg. Your child's teacher will be sharing more details soon. We'll also be gearing up for our first fundraiser and, of course, the much-anticipated Halloween Parades! Crossroads will be hosting their annual Trunk or Treat event as well. It's going to be a busy and fun season, and we can't wait to share it with you! -Evelyn & Lesly

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Tuition

Tuition payments are due on the 1st of each month. Payments <u>received after the 10th of each month</u>, including automatic payments generated from your bank, will incur a \$35 late fee. This fee will automatically be applied to your child's tuition account. Please make checks payable to <u>HOPE Preschool</u>.

Payment Methods

You can pay your child's tuition in one of several ways:

- Place your check/money order in the gray tuition drop box in the office or in the black drop box at entrance #3.
- Automatic payment through your financial institution.
- Fill out our ACH Recurring Payment Form to have tuition withdrawn monthly from your bank account.
- You can also <u>prearrange</u> with Debbie Flowers for an exact cash payment.


All families should notify the HOPE office of ALL student absences by calling 703-729-4673. If a child has been diagnosed by a physician with a contagious illness, we will send a confidential email to all affected families.



Keep your child home if they have had the following symptoms in the past 24 hours:

- Fever
- Vomit
- Diarrhea
- Excessive coughing or sneezing
- Positive Covid, Flu, Strep, or RSV test
- Crusty nose or mucus
- Pink eye/oozing eye
- Unusual spots or rash on skin
- Head Lice


