
#### Payment Methods

# Snack Policy - PLEASE READ

HOPE Preschool attempts to be a NUT FREE \* HOPE Staff will be checking food labels facility.

- \* Do not send in any foods containing any \* type of nut or nut oil. This does include but  $\star$ not limited to Nutella and peanut butter.
- \* Any food with the following warning is not acceptable: This product is made on equipment that also makes products containing nuts.
- for **nut ingredients only**.
- \* No homemade goods will be served.
- All snacks must be in sealed, prepackaged containers with English labels.
- \* Please refer to HOPE's Preferred Snack List for acceptable snacks.
- No candy will be served.



# Inclement Weather Policy

HOPE Preschool follows a similar schedule to Loudoun County Public Schools when closing or delaying school opening.

The following is our Inclement Weather Policy:

If LCPS is delayed 1 OR 2 hours, HOPE will open at 10 am.

(This does not affect dismissal time.)

Email notifications will also be sent to families.




#### Carline Policy

HOPE Preschool strongly encourages the use of carline during dropoff and pick-up to expedite arrivals and dismissals. We ask that you follow these rules to ensure the safety of all children:

- Drive Slowly.
- NO CELL PHONES.
- RIGHT TURN ONLY to exit.
- Children using carline must have a child restraint device in the vehicle. This includes vehicles of grandparents, nannies, or others who will be picking up your child. Staff will not place children in a vehicle without a restraint device.
- Once your child has been placed in your car, if the teacher is unable to properly secure your child, pull into a recent parking

space to do so.

- DO NOT get out of your car for any reason while in carline.
- Follow the one-way loop as shown in the parent handbook.
- Place your car in park when loading and unloading children.
- Please relay these rules to others who may be transporting your child





# Absentee Policy

We can all agree that healthy practices and good hygiene are more important than ever these days for ourselves and for those we encounter. If your child has a fever, vomited in the past 24 hours, had diarrhea, excessive coughing or sneezing, runny nose, red eyes, or just isn't feeling well and not their usual self, **PLEASE** keep them home and allow them to rest.

All families should notify the HOPE office of ALL student absences by calling 703-729-4673. If a child has been diagnosed by a physician with a contagious illness, we will send a confidential email to all affected families.



Keep your child home when they have had the following symptoms in the past 24 hours:

- Fever
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Positive Covid, Flu, Strep, or RSV
- Excessive coughing/sneezing
- Crusty nose or mucus
- Pink eye/oozing eye
- Unusual spots or rash on skin
- Head Lice

## Security Procedure

HOPE Preschool is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our students and staff. During the school year, we will have our perimeter doors locked while children are in attendance. This procedure allows us to maintain a secure facility. If you need to pick up a child early from school, please use the door bell at entrance #3. A staff member will answer the door and assist you in retrieving your child. Thanks for your understanding and cooperation.

Please make every attempt to arrive on time each morning. Once the doors are locked, our children have settled into their class routine. Children who arrive late often miss out on a free exploration opportunity.

# Lunch Bunch Program



Lunch Bunch is an opportunity for students to extend their regular school day by enjoying lunch, friends, and play while providing parents a little extra time. Each child brings his/her **nut free** lunch, which does not require cooking or refrigeration, from home in a labeled bag or lunchbox. Two HOPE staff members (provided there are 5 or more registered students) will care for the children and oversee their activities.

#### Registration Information:

- Space is available on a first come, first served basis.
- Registration forms will be announced via email, allowing all families to receive information on the same day.
- Cost per day is \$30.

- Students remain at school until 1:30.
- There will be NO carline available for pick-up.

#### Remember: HOPE Preschool is a Nut-Free Facility.
